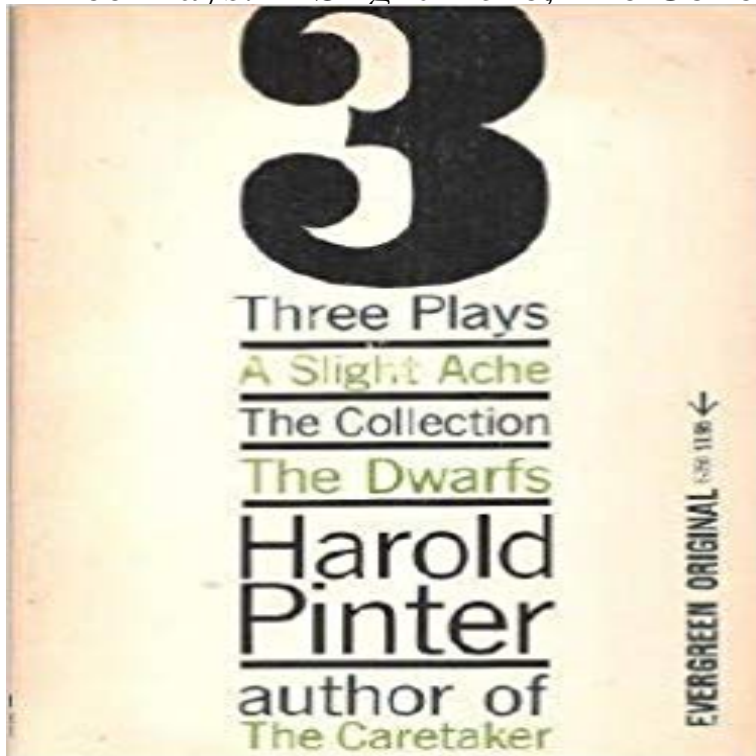


Three Plays: A Slight Ache, The Collection, and The Dwarfs
