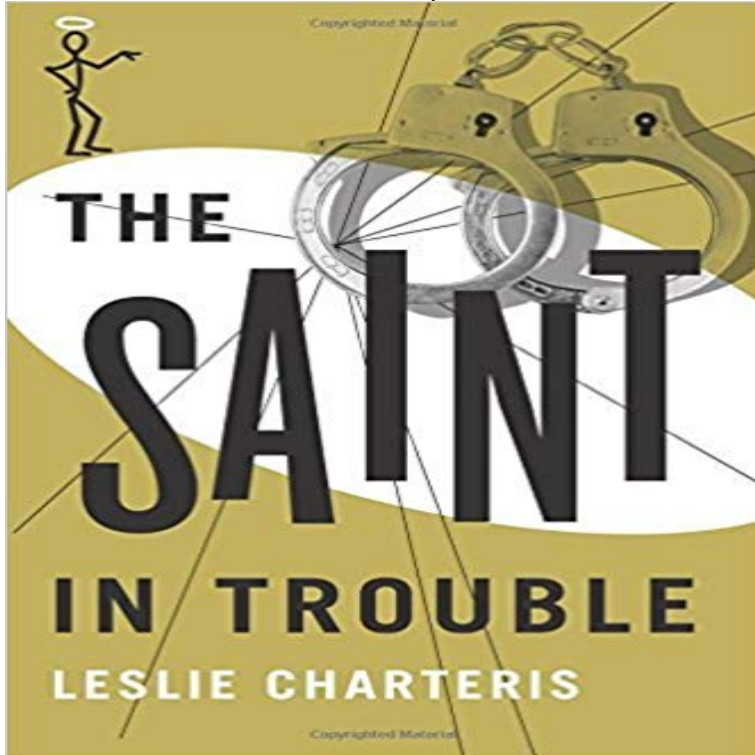


## The Saint in Trouble (The Saint Series)
