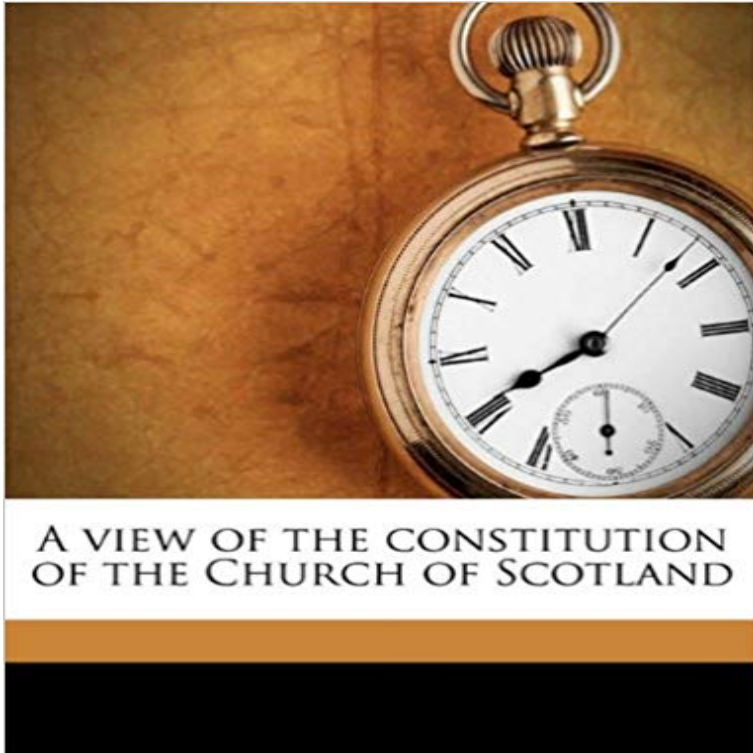


A view of the constitution of the Church of Scotland
