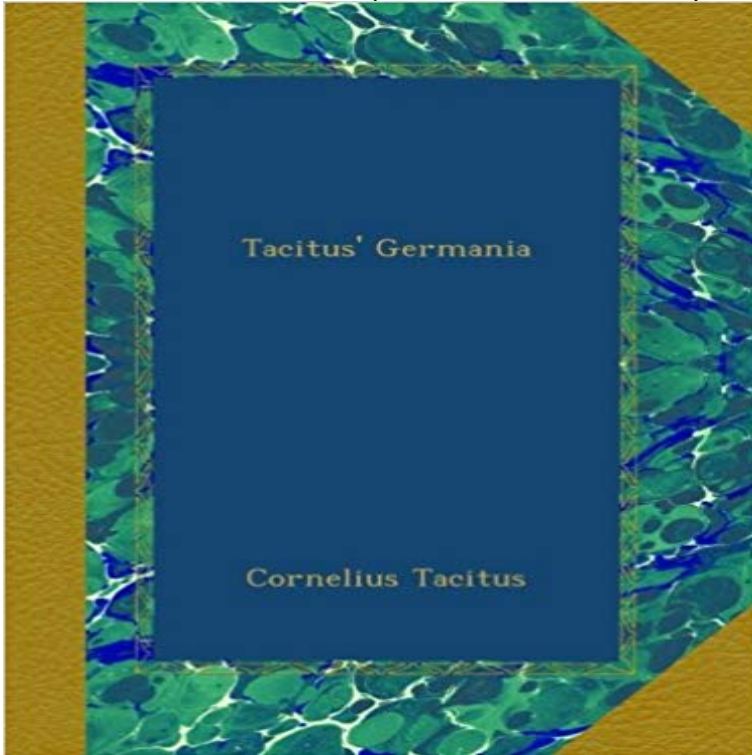


Tacitus Germania (German Edition)
