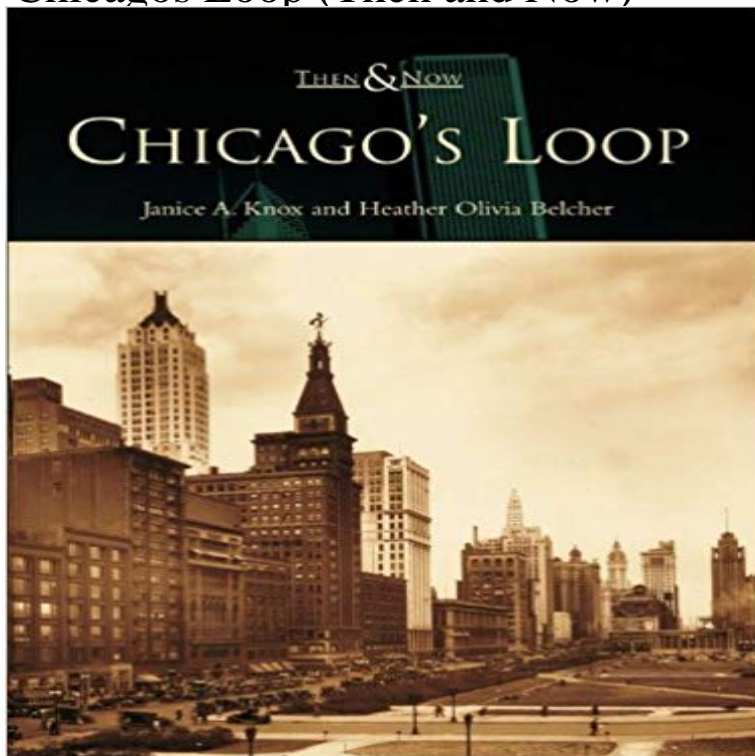


## Chicagos Loop (Then and Now)
