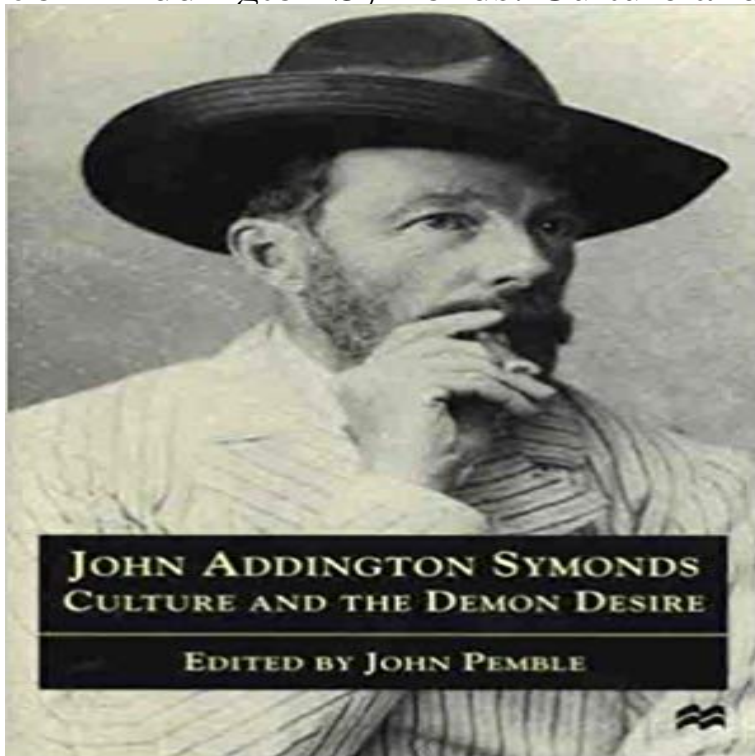


John Addington Symonds: Culture and the Demon Desire
