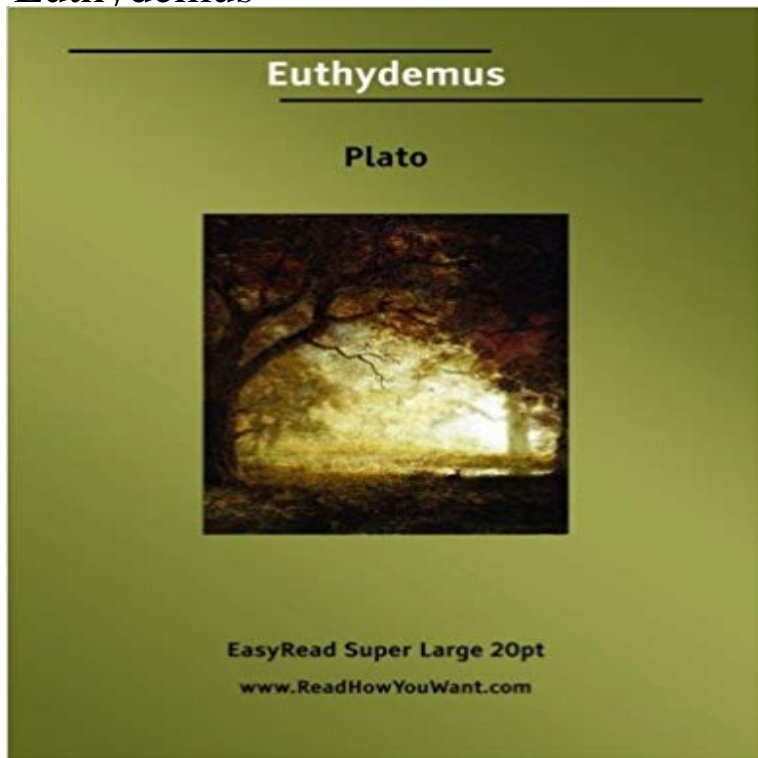


Euthydemus
