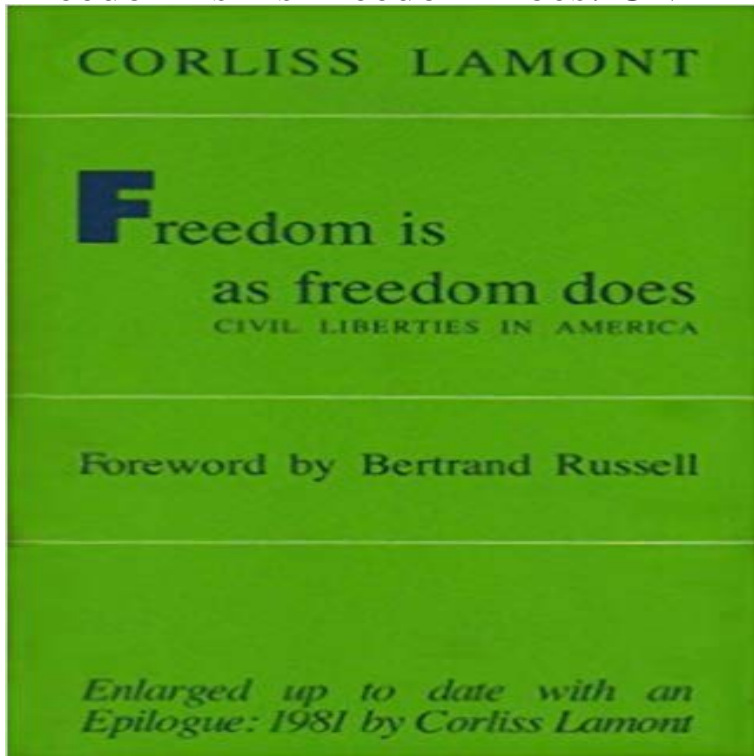


Freedom Is As Freedom Does: Civil Liberties in America
