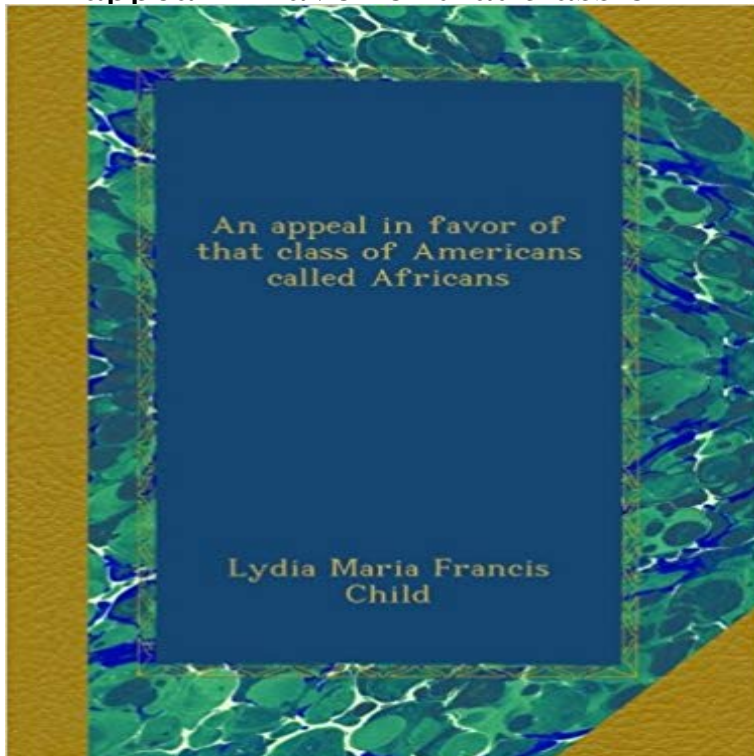


An appeal in favor of that class of Americans called Africans
