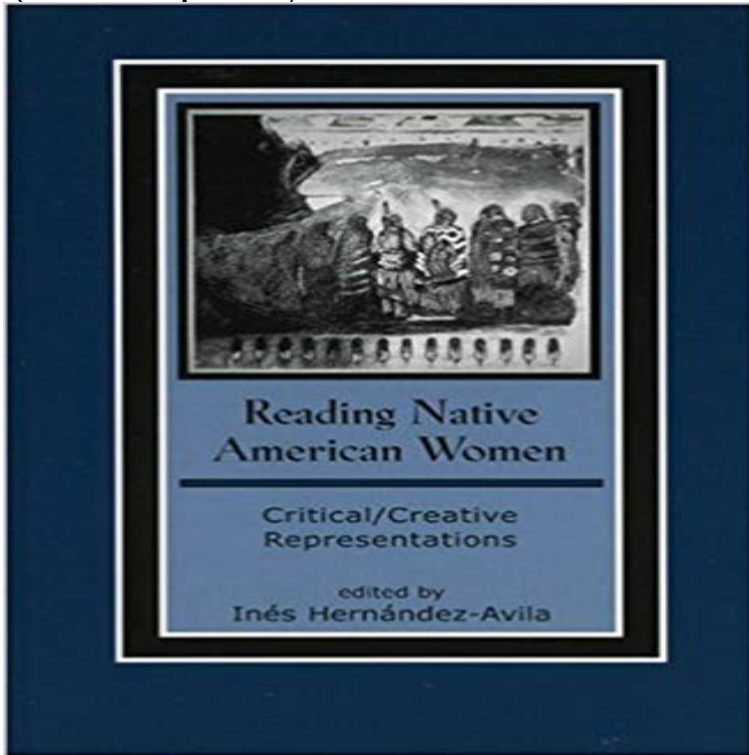


Reading Native American Women: Critical/Creative Representations (Contemporary Native American Communities)
