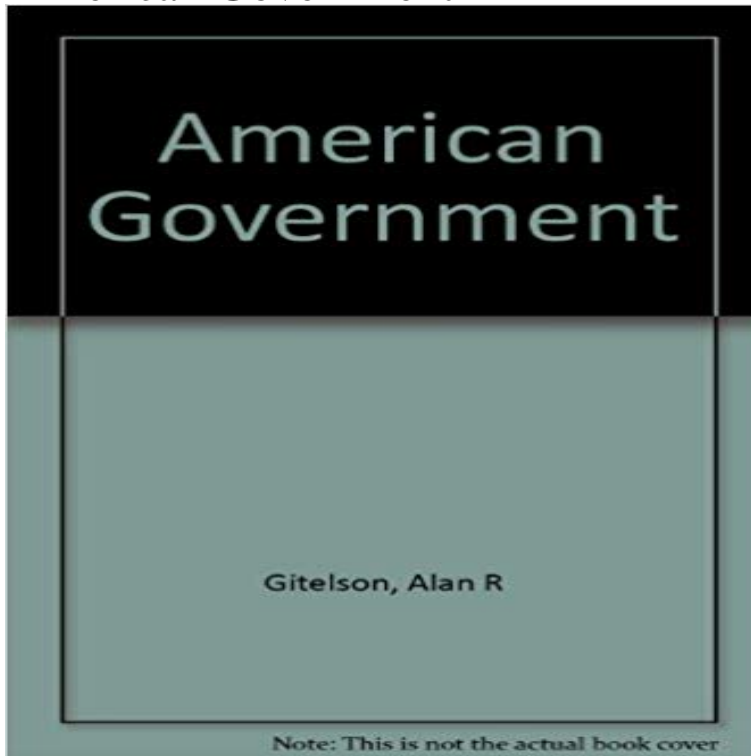


# American Government



The brief edition maintains the framework of the complete text, emphasizing the historical development of the American political system, who governs, and to what end. Additional updates include discussions of current topics such as the U.S.A Patriot Act, recent Supreme Court decisions, and the Department of Homeland Security. An expanded discussion on education addresses how students may be influenced by interactions with campus organizations, political movements, and social contacts and how they may in turn affect public opinion.
