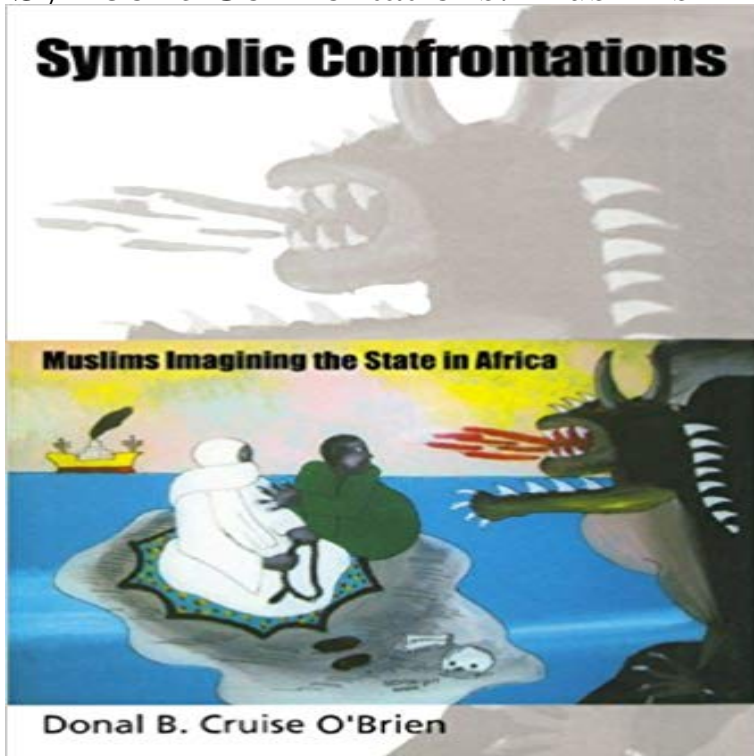


Symbolic Confrontations: Muslims Imagining the State in Africa

The book focuses on Senegal, a fascinating example of the spread of Muslim brotherhoods and their overarching influence on the construction and decision-making processes of the state.
