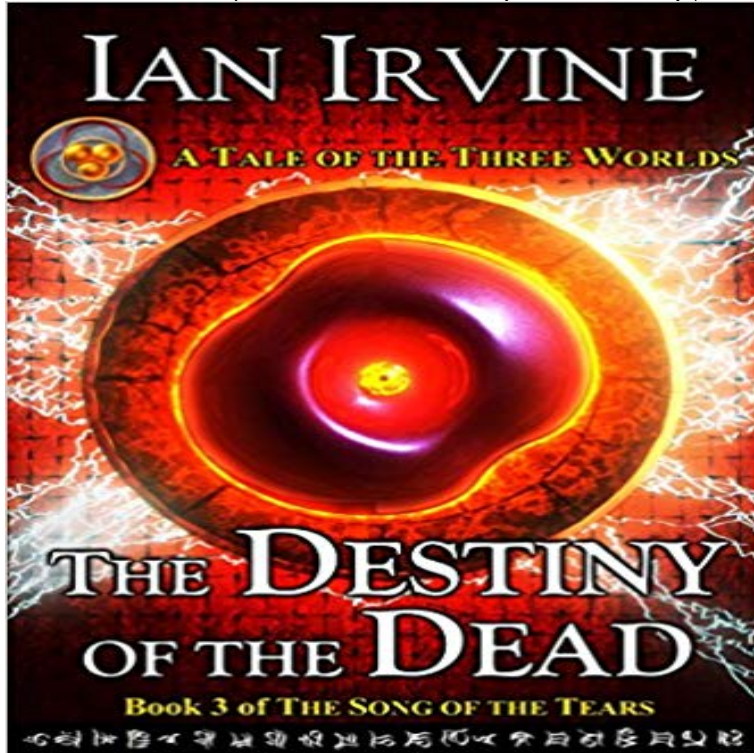


The Destiny of the Dead (The Song of the Tears Book 3)
