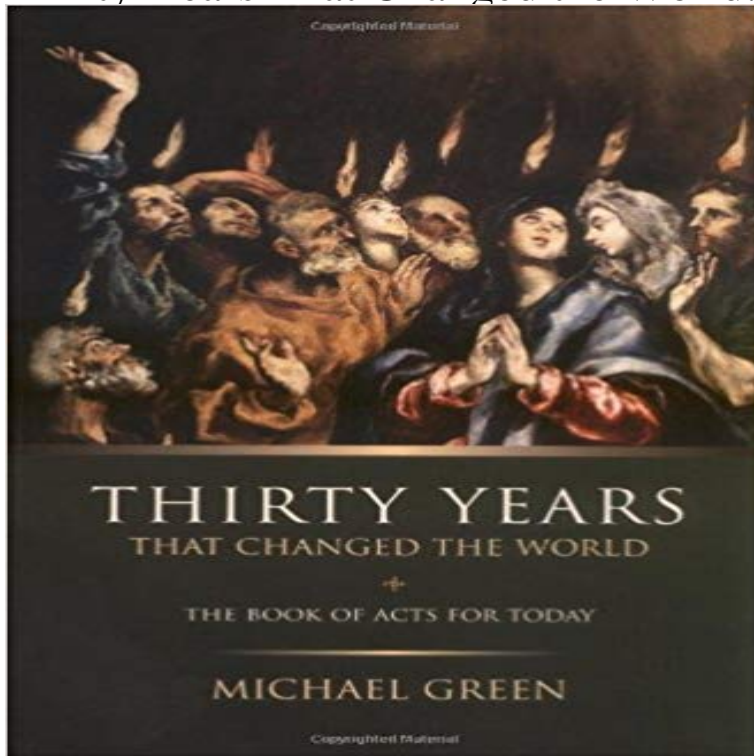


## Thirty Years That Changed the World: The Book Acts for Today
