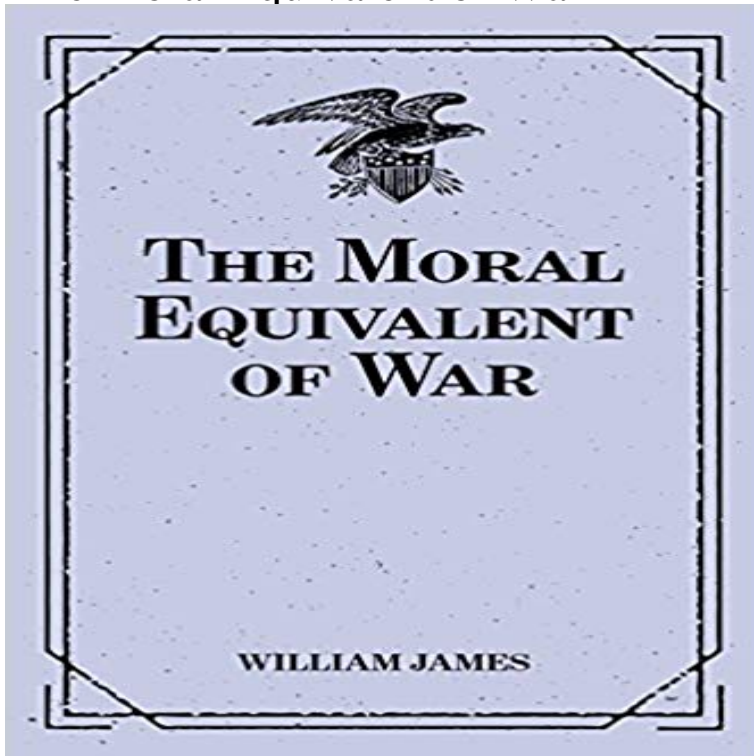


## The Moral Equivalent of War
